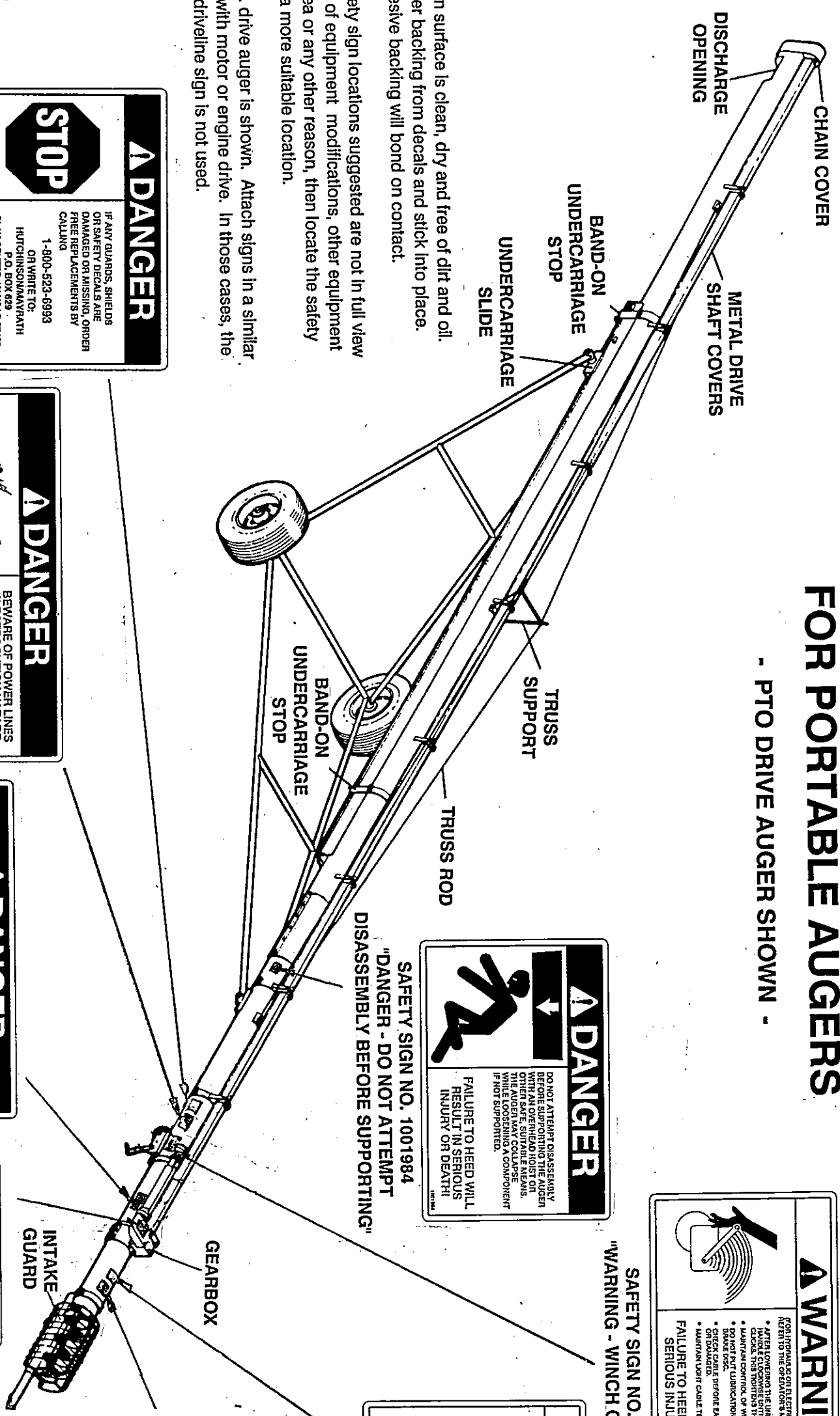


HUTCHINSON SAFETY SIGN KIT FOR PORTABLE AUGERS

WARNING

ROTATING SHAFT OR ELECTRICAL WIRING OPERATION. PLEASE REFER TO THE OPERATOR'S MANUAL PROVIDED WITH UNIT.)
 • AFTER LOWERING THE LIFT, ALWAYS TURN THE WINCH HANDLE CLOCKWISE UNTIL YOU HEAR AT LEAST TWO CLONKS. THIS TIGHTENS THE BRAKE LOCK.
 • MAINTAIN CONTROL OF ANY HANDLE AT ALL TIMES.
 • DO NOT ATTEMPT TO OPERATE THE AUGER ON THE

▲ CAUTION

1. READ AND UNDERSTAND THE OPERATOR'S MANUAL BEFORE OPERATING.
2. DO NOT REMOVE OR MODIFY ANY GUARDS.
3. MAKE CERTAIN EVERYONE IS CLEAR BEFORE OPERATING OR MOVING THE MACHINE.
4. KEEP HANDS, FEET, HAIR AND CLOTHING AWAY FROM MOVING PARTS.
5. STOP MACHINE AND LOCKOUT POWER TO ADJUST, SERVICE OR CLEAN.
6. EMPTY MACHINE AND LOWER TO TRANSPORT POSITION FOR TRANSPORTING.
7. DO NOT ATTEMPT TO MOVE MACHINE MANUALLY. USE A TOWING VEHICLE.

ROTATING DRIVELINE
 • KEEP BOOY, HAIR AND CLOTHING AWAY FROM ROTATING DRIVELINE.
 • USE ONLY WITH ADEQUATE TRACTION HAVING SAG ROM POWER TAKE OFF.
 • KEEP ALL PROTECTIVE GUARDS AND SHIELDS IN PLACE AND ATTACHED AT ALL TIMES.
 • MAKE SURE DRIVELINE BELT IS TIGHTLY ON DRIVE PULLEY.
 • KEEP CHILDREN WELL CLEAR OF WORK AREA.
 FAILURE TO HEED WILL RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH!

"DANGER - ROTATING DRIVELINE"

▲ DANGER

PENDING HAZARD
 • SUPPORT DISCHARGE RUD OR ANCHOR INTAKE END TO PREVENT UPENDING.
 • DO NOT PUSH THE UNDERCARRIAGE BY HAND.
 • HIGHER THAN VEHICLE END BAR, MAINTAIN BAR ON GROUND.
 • LOWER TO TRANSPORT POSITION IMMEDIATELY WHEN CLEAR FROM GRAIN STORAGE STRUCTURE.
 FAILURE TO HEED WILL RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH!

 • KEEP HANDS, FEET, HAIR AND CLOTHING AWAY FROM ROTATING AUGER.

 • KEEP CHILDREN WELL CLEAR OF WORK AREA.
 FAILURE TO HEED WILL RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH!

"DANGER - ROTATING AUGER"

If the safety sign locations suggested are not in full view because of equipment modifications, other equipment in the area or any other reason, then locate the safety signs in a more suitable location.

A P.T.O. drive auger is shown. Attach signs in a similar manner with motor or engine drive. In those cases, the rotating driveline sign is not used.

Be certain surface is clean, dry and free of dirt and oil. Peel paper backing from decals and stick into place. The adhesive backing will bond on contact.
